The first and more important of these is ***The Handbook for Undergraduate Students***. *You must download it and read it thoroughly* or you may, in the case of late essays for example, incur severe and unexpected penalties. Not having read the Handbook is no defence against the charge of having failed to comply with any of the regulations that it contains. Pay special attention to the marking and grading scales, to the rules that govern essay submission, and to the sections on Missed Classes, Late Submission of Work, Academic Alert and Plagiarism. (This last is probably the most important section of all: the School pursues plagiarists vigorously. Major or repeat offenders may be prevented from entering, or may be removed from the Honours Class.) This handbook also lists important web addresses.

Also important is the ***Essay Stylesheet & Guidelines***. Make sure that your essays comply with this document. Failure to do so may cost you marks.
