Welcome to the first Pure newsletter from the University of St Andrews. In this our first issue we will focus on the "scan for publications" feature which allows users to set up regular scans of the online resources linked to Pure such as Web of Science.

### In Focus: the Scanning Service

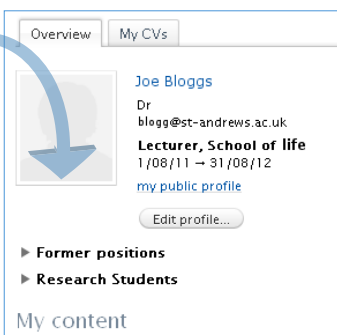
This new service allows you to set up a regular scan of the online resources linked to Pure, including arXiv and Web of Science (WOS). You can also add name variants to search for publications under your maiden name or with different initials, etc. The scan initially searches back 30 days and will then run every 7 days.

The scanning service is activated via the edit profile button.

In the edit profile window that appears, select "setup scan for publications in online sources" from the navigation list.

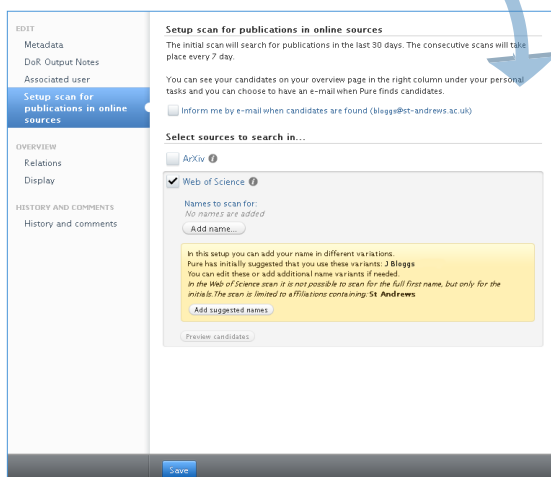
From the Scan screen you can:

- Choose a scanning source
- add name variants to scan
- preview the scan results



Results for the scan will be displayed in the task pane below the Add new button. You can also choose to receive your results by email.

By clicking on your results you can then import any of the suggested candidates.
