

The Offer Holder Checklist

As the end of the academic year fast approaches, you may be wondering what your next steps are on your journey to the University of St Andrews. This checklist provides important reminders to applicants who have received an offer to study with us.

Types of offer

- An **unconditional offer**. This means that you have already achieved the required grades or qualifications to study your selected course, and your offer has been confirmed.
- A **conditional offer**. This means your offer is conditional on you achieving certain grades or qualifications. Please check your offer letter for your specific offer conditions.

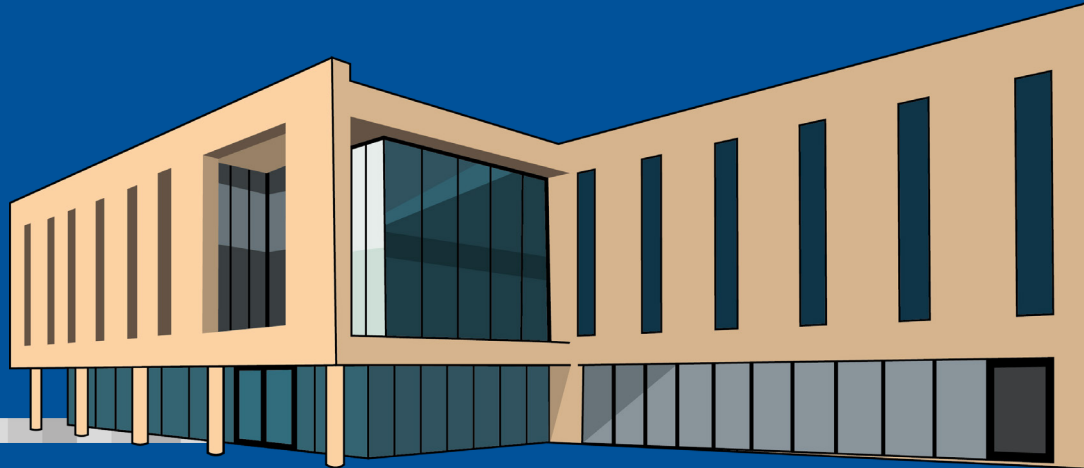


Respond to your offer



- Please refer to your offer letter, which will detail how to respond to your offer and any specific deadlines. We recommend that you accept your place as soon as possible.

Make the pre-payment



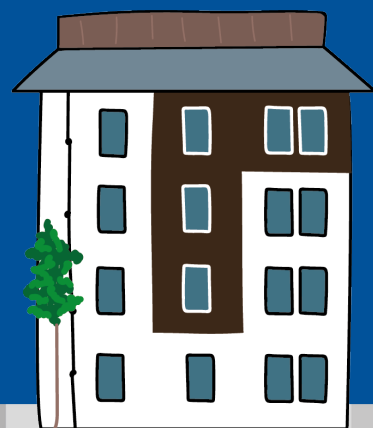
- Your offer letter will indicate if you are required to make a pre-payment to accept and secure your place. Your pre-payment will be deducted from the total cost of your tuition fees.

Apply for accommodation



- You can apply for university accommodation 48 hours after accepting an offer, regardless of whether your offer is conditional or unconditional.
- The online accommodation application form is open. While there is no deadline for postgraduate accommodation applications, university accommodation is a popular choice, so you are encouraged to apply as early as possible.

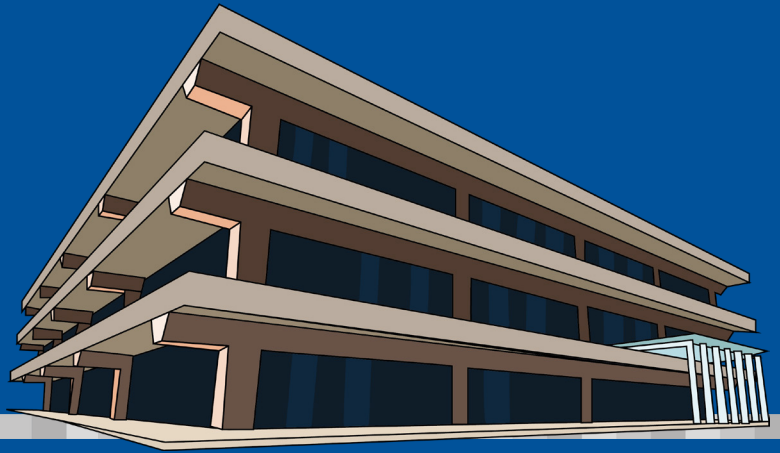

Apply for a Student visa

- If you are an International, EU, EEA or Swiss student studying in the UK for more than six months, you will likely need to apply for a Student visa before you enter the UK.

- You can start the visa application process if you have accepted an Unconditional offer and have received your CAS (Confirmation of Acceptance of Studies) number. If you have accepted a Conditional offer, you will be able to apply for the visa if you meet the conditions of your offer and your place is confirmed, and you have received your CAS number.

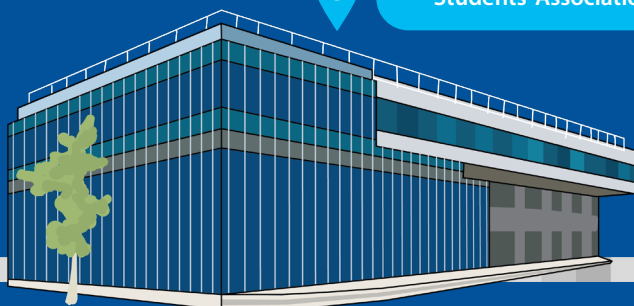

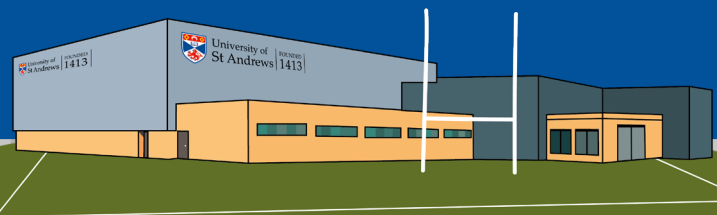
