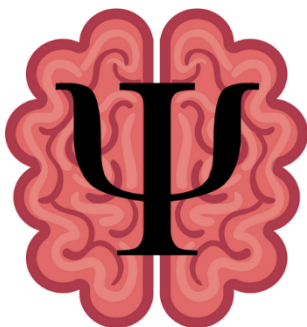
NEUROSCIENCE SOCIETY
