

Global Online Year One programme academic entry requirements
Typical requirements based on national qualifications
Valid from 10 June 2020

Typical academic entry requirements based on national high school qualifications for the Global Online Year One (GOYO) programme are shown below. The countries listed reflect the fact that GOYO is for students whose status is international for fees purposes.

Requirements for those wishing to study **International Relations** as their intended degree are higher than those shown in the table.

Minimum requirements for standard qualifications

A-Level: BBB

International Baccalaureate: 32

To be eligible for the GOYO, your national high school qualification must be obtained after 12 or 13 years of full-time education and be recognised as equivalent to AS Level or above.

International students who have completed fewer than 12 years of schooling, or who have obtained IGCEs or equivalent as their school leaving qualification, may be eligible for our **International Foundation and International Year One Science programmes**: <https://www.st-andrews.ac.uk/subjects/study-options/foundation/programmes/>.

The grades shown in the table below are a guide only. We make offers on a holistic basis, looking at your whole application and not only your academic results. Where your grades are slightly below our stated academic requirement, you should ask your referee to provide an explanation in your high school reference or address this issue in your personal statement.
